Pout Pond Beach Rules

Per order of the Conservation Commission

- Everyone entering the beach (including non-swimmers) must check in with the beach attendant and pay admission or provide proof of Season Pass
- All transactions are FINAL, there are no refunds
- Only Coast Guard approved lifejackets and devices may be used
- Child 'Water Wings' may only be used in the roped off swimming area and must be supervised at all times
- Patrons requiring the use of diapers MUST use swim diapers
- All patrons must wear appropriate swim attire (including infants & children)
- All patrons must be 12+ or accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times
- No patrons are permitted in the designated ecologically sensitive areas
- No pulling or hanging on the swimming ropes
- No lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk
- No pushing, roughhousing, or dangerous behavior
- No motorized or powered boats allowed
- All watercraft patrons must comply with all US Coast Guard Regulations
- No fishing from the beach
- No dogs or other pets allowed on the beach (except service animals in accordance with the ADA)
- No glass containers or alcoholic beverages
- Bikes must be kept in the designated areas
- NO SMOKING ALLOWED

Anyone violating these rules or acting inappropriately will be asked to leave
