The Uxbridge Town Scholarship Committee is pleased to offer the LW Tank Tradesman Scholarship(s) of between \$1000 to \$3000 to deserving Uxbridge residents that have been accepted to pursue education beyond the secondary school level in the **trades**. This scholarship is not restricted to Uxbridge High School students. Awards are paid directly to the school and applied to tuition and fees.

The awarding of these scholarships is based on the following criteria:

1. The applicant must be an Uxbridge resident.
2. The applicant must have a GPA of 80% or higher (attach a high school transcript or equivalent).
3. The applicant must be accepted at an approved trade program at an accredited two-year college, vocational, technical school, or other approved technical institute in the United States (attach a copy of the acceptance letter). **Four-year degree or bachelor programs are not eligible.**
4. The financial need of student. Include a copy of the financial aid award letter from the accepted institution and listing of any additional scholarships you won.
5. Proof of residency (provide proof with this form).
6. Include two (2) character reference letters: one from a party connected to school, i.e., teacher, coach, admin, etc.; one from outside the school community, i.e., boss, neighbor, clergy, etc.
7. A maximum of a two-page typed essay: "Why do I feel I'm the best candidate for this Scholarship?"
