Pout Pond Land Use Regulations

Pout Pond is a Conservation and Recreation Area open to the public, and held by the Uxbridge Conservation Commission. The following regulations have been adopted to protect the land and animals, as well as to protect visitors and ensure that everyone has a pleasant and safe visit to Pout Pond.

- Pout Pond is open dawn to dusk. No trespassing after dark.
- No trespassing with motorized recreational vehicles. (Motorized recreational vehicles such as ATVs and dirt bikes cause damage to trails, are hazardous for other users of trails, kill wildlife, and create a noise nuisance which is disturbing for wildlife and people).
- No motorized vehicles of any kind on beach or lawn areas; vehicles must remain in designated travel and parking locations. Carry-in boating is encouraged.
- No gasoline-powered watercraft.
- Dogs must remain on a leash at all times. (Dogs off-leash can pose a hazard to people. Many people are afraid of dogs. Dogs off-leash also may chase down wildlife and destroy nests).
- Please pick up after your dog.
- Recreational hunting is allowed as permitted in accordance with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Rules and Regulations. Fishing which conforms to state rules and regulations is permitted.
- Open fires are not allowed except by special permit, issued by the Uxbridge Conservation Commission.
- Swimming is limited to the maintained beach area and is at your own risk.
- There is no trash collection. Please keep Pout Pond clean and beautiful. Carry out what you carry in!
