**1) Continued Public Hearing, Down East LLC, variance from Board of Health Regulation Minimum Sanitation Standards for Private and Semi-Public Wells Article XIV, section 14.8 Moratorium A. in order to blast for town water for a new subdivision.**

Proponent did not show for the continuation. Notification of inability to attend was not submitted, no revised plans or list of potential hydro-geologists were submitted.

**2) Michael Catalano, Colonial Engineering, 90 Rockmeadow Road, variance 3' offset to groundwater, repair.** Board of Health engineer has not approved plans. Continued until 1/3/2008.

**3) Seth Lajoie, Seth L. Lajoie and Associates, Inc., 385 Hazel Street, variance 3' to groundwater, repair.** Board of Health engineer has not approved plans. Continued until 1/3/2008.

**New Business: Review 81P for Planning Board.** Although the Board has no comments on these plans they did reiterate that the septic plans require a statement as to whether or not the parcel is within the 3000' no blast zone.

**Review proposed 2009 Budget,** error found, will be brought to the attention of the Director of Planning & Economic Development.

**PAYT Program,** Cay Den Herder gave updates to the Board; the RFP is nearly completed and will be the next step in completing the process for this program. The Board discussed need to review and update curbside hauling regulations.

**Old Business:** Sue Smith advised Board members that the contact plan for the Emergency Preparedness Plan is nearly completed.
