**ARTICLE TO AMEND THE ZONING BYLAWS**

To see if the Town will vote to amend the Town of Uxbridge Zoning Bylaws, in Article X, "Definitions", the definition of "Manufacturing establishment":

By striking the following sentence:

"Specifically expected (sic) are: tanneries, wood pulp or paper mills, meat packing, slaughter house and/or meat rendering, and pet food plants which are prohibited."

And replacing it with:

"Specifically prohibited are: tanneries, wood pulp or paper mills, meat packing, slaughterhouse and/or meat rendering, petroleum and coal product manufacturing, and bituminous asphalt manufacturing, and pet food plants all of which are prohibited in all zones."

**MEETING POSTINGS:**

Except in an emergency, a public body must post notice of a meeting at least 48 hours in advance, excluding Saturday's, Sunday's and legal holidays, except in emergencies. "Emergency" is a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action. In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to a meeting. Notice must include date, time and place of meeting. Must include listing of topics the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting. Topics must give enough specificity so that the public will understand what will be discussed at the meeting. Public bodies are encouraged to update the notice when aware of new topics within the 48 hour period before the meeting. Chairs should not post notices so far in advance that there is a high likelihood that new topics will arise, unless the chair updates the notice with any such new topics 48 hours in advance of the meeting.
