Uxbridge Residents Only

- The Composting / Recycling Facility located adjacent to the Wastewater Treatment Facility on River Road will be in operation beginning April 2, 2016. (See 2016 calendar on reverse side for schedule of dates and times.)
- Permit stickers for facility use for 2016:
Residents \$20; Commercial landscapers (Composting Permit) \$50; Check or Cash only.
Payable in advance at the DPW office, 147 Hecla Street, Monday thru Friday 8:00 am - 4:00 pm
- Commercial landscapers (COMPOSTING ONLY) disposal fees:
Per load: \$20 pickup; \$30 1 ton truck; \$80 larger than 1 ton truck.
Payable at time of disposal by check only
- Proof of Residence (driver's license) must be shown to obtain sticker. Sticker must be attached and displayed on the window on driver's side of vehicle.
- COMPOSTING Acceptable items:
Leaves and grass trimmings: Loose or bio bagged only (No plastic).
Brush: 6" Diameter or less, 8' Length or less only.
- RECYCLING Acceptable items:
Appliances, air conditioners
Lawnmowers & snow blowers (gas/oil removed), most metal products.
NO PROPANE TANKS, BATTERIES, TVs, MICROWAVES, COMPUTERS
Permit holder must place item in dumpster

Recycling is available only to Uxbridge residents. No commercial recycling permits will be issued.

Anyone caught dumping unaccepted items will have their permit revoked.

The compost facility operates with limited staffing. Through the efforts of the Tax Work-Off Program, we are able to be open additional hours during the summer and fall months. Unfortunately, should there be an emergency or illness and no staff coverage available, this facility may close without notice.
