Call to Order: 7:00pm

Quorum: 5/5 in attendance.

Treasurer's Report: Sandy Lemire reporting. Balance \$4,038.20. Treasurer's report accepted.

Old Business

Concerns of Members, forum: Squash bugs continue to be an issue. We may need to consider not planting anything in the squash family next year. It is recommended to aerate the soil and add organic compost.

Message Board / Sign: The signs and message board have been installed. A chain was added to hold the plexiglass in place. Information has been posted. Charlene Miller will paint the logo on the board.

Hat sales & Inventory: sales ongoing

Water Solution: The tops of the trough have been painted. The fire chief will fill the tank and rain barrels this week. Barbara is researching solar-powered pumps and well options. Ongoing fundraising is necessary. Permits will be required prior to install.

Food Pantry Garden: 2-3 additional plots will be added for next year. A large bin was installed for donated vegetables. Food pantry volunteers will pickup produce several times a week.
