UXBRIDGE HISTORICAL COMMISSION

MEETING MINUTES
September 15, 2015

Meeting opened by President J Francis Cove at 3:05pm

Minutes from 7/21/15 meeting were reviewed. Motion made to accept, seconded.

Old Business:

1. Update was given regarding the clean-up of the perimeters of the vacant lot by the Town DPW.
2. A report was given regarding additional information received on the cell tower plans. It was reported the tower would be approx 140' tall with a base of approx 12' x 12' to be located at the back of Town Hall and replacing the current tower. Concerns were voiced about the size and location of the tower and a request was made for more information on size and placement of tower. It was suggested the Commission attend the next Historic District meeting to hear a report from Town Manager and Fire Chief.
3. Update was given on the installation of fence at 47 North Main St. property. Historical Commission was informed of the warrant for Town Meeting to abolish the Historic District Commission.

New Business:

1. Letter received from Ironstone School regarding their upcoming centennial and open house to be held on 9/19/15.
2. William Albin reported the Uxbridge Historical Society has a Civil War Re-enactment program coming up on 9/30/15 at the Senior Center. A film and history of the war and a video of a Voss Farm encampment representing both sides will be shown.
