WHERE: Town of Uxbridge-Lower Town Hall 21 South Main Street Uxbridge, MA 01569 WHEN: Thursday, April 25, 2013 @ 7:00 PM PURPOSE: The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Uxbridge-Reconstruction & Signal Improvements on Route 122 (North & South Main Streets) project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible. PROPOSAL: The proposed project consists of pavement rehabilitation with areas of box widening for minor geometric changes to improve horizontal alignment as well as sidewalk installation. Also included in the project are traffic signal upgrade and reconstruction, sidewalk and wheelchair ramp installation, granite curb resetting or installation, box culvert extension and minor drainage improvements, and associated traffic signs and pavement markings. Bicycle accommodations consisting of a usable shoulder have been provided throughout the project corridor in accordance with applicable design guides, except at the Hartford Avenue intersection and in the downtown area where a share the road condition will exist. A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be discussed at this hearing. Written views received by MassDOT subsequent to the date of this notice and up to five (5) days prior to the date of the hearing shall be displayed for public inspection and copying at the time and date listed above. Plans will be on display one-half hour before the hearing begins, with an engineer in attendance to answer questions regarding this project. A project handout will be made available on the MassDOT website listed below. Written statements and other exhibits in place of, or in addition to, oral statements made at the Public Hearing regarding the proposed undertaking are to be submitted to Thomas F. Broderick, P.E., Chief Engineer, MassDOT, 10 Park Plaza, Boston, MA 02116, Attention: Roadway Project Management, Project File No. 604948. Such submissions will also be accepted at the hearing. Mailed statements and exhibits intended for inclusion in the public hearing transcript must be postmarked within ten (10) business days of this Public Hearing.
