POLICY OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN TOWN OF UXBRIDGE, MASSACHUSETTS

Winter Sand Use Policy

Purpose

To provide winter ice treatment material free to Uxbridge residents or property owners for use on their residential driveway or sidewalk.

Administration & Enforcement

The administration and enforcement of this policy is under the authority of the Board of Selectmen.

Conditions of Use

The Department of Public Works may make ice treatment material (sand or sand/salt mix) available to Uxbridge residents or property owners at the Highway Division garage, located at 145 Hecla St., from approximately November 15 through April 15. The DPW will dedicate a storage location near the upper garage that will have pedestrian-only access from the parking area at the Administration building. Ice treatment material is for residential use only. Proof of residence may be requested.

The public shall not enter the Highway Division yard without authorization and shall not help themselves to sand or salt from the Department's material storage buildings.

The Town will not load or supply any shovels for loading material. Ice treatment material will be provided on a first-come-first-served basis. Material shall be taken in small quantities, not to exceed two (2) five-gallon buckets.

Abuse/Controls

This policy shall be posted on the Town website and there are no exceptions to the conditions of this policy. All Town employees are authorized to ask violators to leave or to limit their use of ice treatment material. When violators do not respect the direction from non-police employees, the Uxbridge Police Department may be called to ask violators to leave. Any questions, concerns, or problems with this policy must be addressed to the Board of Selectmen through the Office of the Town Manager.
