Reflexology Regulations

All reflexology establishments and practitioners shall be licensed by the Board of Health. All permits shall expire on May 31. All establishments shall be inspected by the BOH prior to the opening.

Reflexology Practitioner:

Each Reflexology Practitioner shall be licensed by the Board of Health and annually renew license by May 31st. Fees are to be set by the Board of Health.

Shall carry a current certification from a certified school 200 hours – 100 hours practice session and 100 hours – ethics, theory, history, business, anatomy

Shall carry liability insurance and provide it at registration

Creams/Oils if used shall be PH neutral

Reflexology tables/chairs shall be sanitized between clients

Reflexologists shall wear one use disposable gloves & change between clients

Foot bath shall be disinfected between clients

Foot bath shall have a fresh solution for each client

Reflexologists shall dress in a clean professional manner

Bathrooms shall be available

Board of Health shall inspect at will.

Reflexology Business Owner:

Each Establishment shall be licensed by the Board of Health. Licenses are to be renewed annually by May 31st. Fees are to be set by the Board of Health.

Shall provide a FLOOR PLAN

Shall provide Business Permit granted by the Town of Uxbridge

Shall carry liability insurance


Revocation of Permits:

Every permit granted for Reflexology Practitioners or Establishments may be revoked at any time when it shall appear to the Board of Health that such revocation is necessary to protect public health and safety or that the conditions of the permit have been violated.


Any violation of these regulations that recurs within one year following an inspection shall be considered a repeat violation. Such a violation shall be sufficient cause for revocation or suspension of a permit.

The Board of Health may require a new permit fee for each establishment that has its permit revoked.
