Meeting Minutes
January 18, 2020

Old Business:

1. Michael Gallerani and Mary Beauchamp will continue to work on forms for matching grants and Planning Fund Grants for the restoration of the Cornet John Farnum House. Francis Cove explained that Brian Phiffer had done surveys and a plan for many houses and buildings in Uxbridge and that these are in the Secretary of State Francis Galvin's Register of Historic Places. Also, that there are matching grants of \$10,000.00 by the State that are matched by the town.
2. Rob Harris repaired the leak around the upstairs toilet. The seal was broken around the toilet due to the settling of the floor. The kitchen ceiling will need to be painted. A motion was made by Peter Emerick to paint the kitchen ceiling, seconded by Mary Beauchamp and followed by a unanimous vote in favor.
3. Peter Emerick will be in charge of getting an electrician to repair and fix the outside lights.

New Business:

1. The new Town Manager, Steven Sette, will be visiting us and discussing his plans for the future.
2. A motion was made by Roy Henry to change the meeting time from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM on the 3rd Saturday of each month. It was seconded by Michael Potaski and followed by a unanimous vote in favor.
3. A motion was made by Roy Henry to have Michael Potaski represent us at the Library Trustees' meeting and keep us informed about their plans for renovating the library. It was seconded by Faye McCloskey and followed by a unanimous vote in favor.
