Subject: Minutes of 18 February 2021 Commission Meeting

Members in attendance: Mary Beauchamp, David Moriarty, Roy Henry, and Michael Potaski

Members absent: Jeffrey Brochu, Faye McCloskey and Peter Emerick

1. The meeting was called to order at 3:45PM. James Beauchamp was present representing the Historical Society.
2. The Minutes of the 14 January 2021 Commission Meeting were read. David Moriarty moved that they be accepted as written and Roy Henry seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Mary Beauchamp reported that the firm of Spencer, Sullivan, and Vogt (SSV) would be at the Farnum House on 4 March to begin their architectural survey needed for the feasibility study for a potential restoration/rehabilitation of the Farnum House. Members of the sub-committed appointed on 14 January were asked to be present to work with SSV on the project.
4. James Beauchamp reported on his efforts to transcribe Historical Society records dealing with the Town's purchase of the Farnum House and subsequent renovation. Michael Potaski reported on efforts to track the ownership of the House from Cornet John Farnum to the present.
5. David Moriarty provided an update on the Arthur Taft Trust's selection of a contractor for the restoration/rehabilitation of the Unitarian Church.
6. There being no further business, Mr. Potaski moved that the Meeting be adjourned and Mr. Moriarty seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
