





The Northbridge & Uxbridge Police Departments are planning on hosting 2 Youth/Junior Police Academies in the summer of 2019. This is a free 1 week program open to **ANY Northbridge or Uxbridge Residens** who will be entering grades 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th grade as of September 2019. The academy will run Monday through Friday from 8:30 am until approximately 2:00pm. The Academy at the Uxbridge High School will run from July 22-26. The Academy at Northbridge High School will run from August 12-16. Residents from either town are eligible for either academy.

Students will learn about the various aspects of law enforcement to include: criminal investigations, crime scene processing, CPR overview, K-9 activities, criminal law and procedure, accident reconstruction, report writing, etc.

A typical academy day consists of physical training, morning snack, morning classroom session, lunch, afternoon classroom session, clean-up, and then dismissal. Throughout the week there is a major focus on personal accountability and respect. Attendees will be provided a uniform T-shirt.

Applications are available at either Northbridge or Uxbridge Police Departments or either department website. The academy is limited to 25 students. In an effort to open the academy to new students, if you participated in any previous academy program, your application will be reviewed after <u>new</u> applicants are accepted. Any remaining slots will be filled with previous attendees on a first come first serve basis. <u>Deadline for applying</u> <u>will be Friday, July 12^h, 2019</u>. All applicants are required to attach a copy of the student's most recent doctor's physical exam, similar to that required for participation in their school athletics, to this application form. Academy uniforms will be provided by the department and must be worn at all times during the academy. Each participant will be required to provide their own plain black athletic shorts (knee length) and athletic footwear (suitable for running) which will be worn throughout the academy program. The academy staff reserves the right to dismiss any participant as a result of inappropriate conduct or for failure to comply with any academy rules. Admission to the Youth Police Academy is open to any Northbridge or Uxbridge residents. In an effort to open the academy to new students, if you participated in any previous academy program your application will be reviewed after *new* applicants are accepted. Any remaining slots will be filled with previous attendees on a first come first serve basis. Academy class is limited to *25 students only*. Parents/guardians are responsible for transportation for their participant to and from the academy each day. Academy hours are from 8:30am to 2:00 p.m. each day. All forms must be returned by *July 12th, 2019*. No exceptions.
