### I. CALL TO ORDER

It being 9:09 am, the meeting being properly posted, duly called and a quorum being present, the meeting was called to order by Benn Sherman.

### II. OLD BUSINESS

### A. Approval of Minutes:

# B. Public Safety Committee Responsibilities.

This was combined with Article 1 under New Business requested by Town Manager. Committee discussed the history and the scope of the Public Safety Committee. Angle discussed to whether it needs to be a public entity and is it something that falls under the Town Manager. Should the Town Manager look at Public Safety concerns and have meetings with the Departments on a monthly basis to see if they had public safety issues that month. This will be tabled until the next meeting for further discussion.

#### C. Fourth of July Committee.

Benn had spoken with Chief Kessler before the meeting and Chief Kessler said they are using new shells that limit the height. His concern was that they could not use the entrance to the Gym. He said he coordinated with Chief Burke and there will be an orange snow fence going up at end of building, east side to the field and out. There is a 200' barrier between the location of the fireworks going off and the crowd to avoid any injuries if they have a one does not go off correctly. They intend to use the entire field for food trucks and entertainment. Fire will have a fire personnel on the roof of McCloskey for fire safety.

Chief Burke met with them and they are trying to get the CERT Team for parking. Granite and Oak are narrow and they are posted NO Parking on one side. He has not heard from them.

Chief Burke told them 3-4 but he prefers 4. 1 on a bike to assist CERT and 2 in the field to assist with issues there and one to assist with the entrances.

The event will take place on July 7, 2018 and gates will open between 3:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. and fireworks at 9:00 p.m.

Police Details will begin at 6:00 p.m. and end at 10:00 p.m.



4<sup>th</sup> of July Committee have not contacted DPW for barrels for trash. Benn will contact Travis. Fire is all set, Police is all set and Travis should be contacting CERT for further assistance. Chief Burke said they have McCloskey and Taft for off street parking. At the end of the night Chief said Taft traffic will go North and McCloskey traffic will empty out into the center of Town. This will help alleviate the center of town from becoming a nightmare with traffic.

  Benn discussed a compliance plan for accessibility for crosswalks.
