**I. CALL TO ORDER**

Peter Demers was not present- Benn Sherman commented that approximately \$30,000 is being spent this year on tree issues. The consensus is that the services of an arborist is needed.

**A. Request for Speed Limit Signage on East Street**

Committee was advised that the state plans to change highway numbers on Rt. 146. This is in cooperation with a federal directive to change all highway signs to align with the mileage from the state line.
