A. Key Access to Town Property – Update

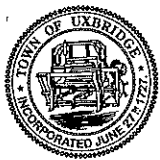
No update by Chief Dion or Benn Sherman

III. NEW BUSINESS

A. Road naming review River Crossing Road.

Mr. Sahagian spoke on a new commercial development, which was originally to be named River Crossing Drive. However, they prefer to now name the road Zipp Drive after a local veteran. The committee voted a favorable recommendation to the BOS 5-0 (motion by Chief Montminy, seconded by Chief Dion).

B. Potential radio frequency access:

Mike Baril commented that the town police department is currently on t-band and may have to abandoned this frequency in the future. Mr. Baril has knowledge of unused frequencies available to the town. The committee agreed to have Chief Montminy continue this discussion and report back to the committee. No vote taken.

C. Cobbler's Knoll:

Mr. Healy, representing "Friends of Scenic Chocolog Road" discussed an inability to get the contractor to abide by the agreed upon terms of the construction in the area. He presented a written statement and there was discussed of the proper venue for this complaint. The Manager agreed to discussions outside of committee. No vote taken.
