I. CALL TO ORDER

It being 9:00 am, the meeting being properly posted, duly called and a quorum being present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman, Marc Montminy.

II. OLD BUSINESS

A. Approval of Minutes:

a.) February 18, 2020

*** Motion by Tom Dion to accept the minutes of the February 18, 2020 Public Safety Meeting. Seconded by Steve Sette. Roll Call taken, all approved. Motion carried 5-0-0.

B. Key access to Town Property - Update.

A call was made to the maker Kober International who gave the name of a Boston company. A key was sent to them to replicate. Chief Montminy said they are a full lock and key company. Tom Dion will take possession of the keys when they are received.

C. Potential Radio frequency access - update.

Work on this has been delayed due to the COIVD-19 virus.



D. Nestor complaint regarding Crosswalk.

Concerned about Linwood @ midpoint closes to the Church. Mike Potaski concerned about vehicles coming Northbound on Linwood Ave., cars cannot see people in the crosswalk. Chief Montminy drove the site and suggested posted speed limit. Benn said the problem is compounded when Church is in attendance due to motorists parking on the street. Chief Montminy to look at the area and make recommendations if any.

III. NEW BUSINESS

A. Mike Potaski request - School Street Parking

Mike Potaski requesting West side of School St. be changed to "No Parking here to corner". Residents and Management park on School St. West side of School Street at this time has no parking anytime.

Benn Sherman to get update from Highway guys about the change.

Plowing: Tenants are told to park on East side during parking lot clean up. Chief said they can park if the during clean up if road is cleared.

B. Stop Sign request at Country Road and East St.

Benn went back to 2011 and they do not show a stop sign in this area. There are issues here East St. is the most major road and there is potential for high speed.

Motion: Chief Montminy entertained a motion by Steve Sette seconded by Tom Dion to have Benn Sherman draft a letter to the Board of Selectmen for consideration of a stop sign at the corner of Country Road and East St. A roll call was taken, all approved. Motion carried 5-0-0

C. Chief Montminy signed BOH Town Common Use Request.

Uxbridge Clean-up Day – April 4, 2020, 9am to 12pm. Cancelled or postponed. BSA Troop 1122 – Plant Sale Fundraising Event – April 25 rain date April 26, 2020 8 am – 4pm. This event may have been cancelled.

D. Pan Mass Challenge

Benn Sherman suggesting alternate route due to E. Hartford Avenue and North Main St. roads being under construction. Benn to check on construction schedule. Pan Mass ride is scheduled for August 1st and 2nd and bikers come through on the first day of the ride.

E. TRITEC RIDE

TriTec will be holding their event on June 19th with approximately 200 cyclists coming through town. Benn said from CVS down E. Harford Ave will be a continuous work zone. Benn asked Tom to recommend they come through the center of town. Tom Dion to call and suggest they look and consider an alternate route.



F. 4th of July event

Travis said this will be the 7th year for this event with the date of the event on Saturday, July 11th with a rain date being Sunday, July 12th.

She said the difference this year are fireworks will begin at 9:30 pm. Chief suggested changing the detail time 6:30pm to 10:30pm. Chief Montminy said based on the assumption that the COVID-19 virus is beyond us the event can be held, if not the event will need to be cancelled.

Travis also informed the committee they plan on placing "No Parking" signs on every telephone pole along Oak and Granite Streets, and parts of Whitin St. All agreed. Chief Montminy said they need a larger number of handicap parking spaces at McCloskey, row closes to the fence. He said this did not happen last year. Travis to bring this back the committee for recommendation.
