SUTTON STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Project Background/History

- MVP Permitting & Funding
 - Resiliency was the focus of MVP1
 - Sutton culvert was selected for funding due to declining condition
 - · MVP funded preliminary design
 - Supplemental Chapter 90 funding was secured to complete the design
 - Construction funding approved through SATM 2023 Article 12
- Flooding Incidents
 - December 2023
 - January 2024

Goals

- Replace failing culvert pipes & improve road surface
- Alleviate drainage issues within the project watershed
- Add resiliency to the watershed for years to come







SUTTON STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Purpose of Article 26

- Issue
 - Culvert infrastructure located outside Right-of-Way
 - Surveyor indicates there are no easements for existing or proposed infrastructure
- Resolution
 - Approx. 1,118 SF of permanent easement is required for both existing and proposed infrastructure improvements
- Town Meeting Action
 - Approval of Article 26 will authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire the necessary easements to construct, maintain, and operate the infrastructure
