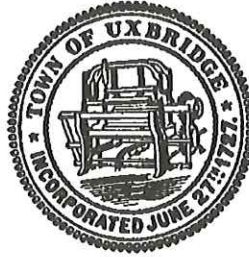

Trash and Recycling Contract

There was some follow up discussion on the presentation included details about which materials were acceptable for recycling: educational issues about recycling; MRF's and recycling incentives and needs.

Committee Status and Reorganization

Katie was welcomed as a new member. She had been appointed by the BOS in June, as had other members and still needs to take the oath of office.

Schools

Mary reviewed the status of the school recycling programs including Green Teams. There has been very little progress made there for a variety of reasons. She has contacted the Superintendent who seems to be on board with having an active recycling program in the schools. Katie had several ideas about how to engage students and parents in promoting recycling, including involvement with the PTO's. Involvement of principals and faculty was also discussed. Katie will join Mary in the effort to address school needs.

Action: Mary and Katie will decide how and whom to approach regarding further next steps

David will contact Green Team coordinator from last year to update status of Green Team Program

Solarize/Heat Smart Program

Christine and David listened in on the seminar about this grant. Given resources, further action on applying for the grant seems unrealistic, although the program itself looks good.

Library Program

The MassSave contractor is available at variety of times to come to our program. After much discussion, the date of December 9 was decided upon. Orlando, Linda, David and Katie can attend. Getting the word out about this program was discussed. Using RSC newsletter, Library calendar and Town website will all be employed.

Action: Explore ways to advertise the program, especially through a school system wide newsletter system. David and Katie will check this out.
