- 2. BUSINESS
 - a) Interview Candidates for School Committee

The following candidates were interviewed: Matt Keane – 6:30 PM, present via Zoom; Claudia Tamsky – 7:00 PM, present in person; Michael Dion – 7:30 PM, present in person.

School Committee candidates introduced themselves, provided a brief overview of their past experience, and why they wanted to be on the School Committee. The School Committee started with their round of questions for each candidate, followed by questions from the Board of Selectmen.

Questions from the School Committee consisted of: why candidates wanted to join and what they planned to accomplish; relevant and applicable skills; best ways to address differences between the staff and administration; how best to support the growing community of bilingual learners; what a high functioning school district looks like and needs (aside from numerical data,); what the biggest opportunities in the District may be; how the School Committee should interact with the Superintendent and Administration; and, candidates were asked about a risk they've taken and the result of that risk.

Board of Selectmen questions consisted of: what the major issues or challenges in the district are; what makes each candidate the best option for the open seat; if candidates would remain on the School Committee and serve a full year term until the next election; candidates' perspective on the School Committee policy book and what possible changes to that are most important; how to hold individuals accountable; and, a comment of Thanks to the candidates for volunteering their time.






