@ 3' TAFT can fit 100% Pre-K

- (1) Special (Elective) for 8 week
- (2) Classrooms 6' apart = cafeteria capacity

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- (3) Bathrooms designated per grade (cohort)
- (4) Special Education = (cohort)
- (5) Pre-K thru GR 1 to use Seesaw

WHITIN School Status = Leanne DeMarco

Logistics easier at WHITIN than at TAFT

4th/5th GR segregated from 6th/7th GR

WHITIN COHORTS

4th GR = done

5th GR > will need adjustments

6th/7th GR homerooms are COHORTED

WHITIN SPECIALS

4TH/5TH will be 6 week schedule

6th/7th (2) identified per trimester

UHS Status: M. Rubin

GOAL > keep existing UHS offering intact

UHS can accommodate 100% at 3' spacing

9th/10th GR at approx. 140 students each class

COHORTING not condusive at UHS level

UHS staff fluent on Google Classroom

Learning Loss needs to be monitored

DESE guidelines VERY prohibitive toward PERFORMING ARTS

Dividers installed in UHS labs (PROACTIVE)

ATHLETICS : logistics will be an issue (i.e. transportation)

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SPECIAL EDUCATION Status : J. Ramsdell

Protocol will be Building based

100% High Need Students = In-Person

DESE instructing to provide services as stated per IEP

Some services will be \$\$ challenging (need specified)

UPS FACILITIES Status: Brian Hyde / Scott

PPE expenditure = \$40k (1st 2 months)

Tech > ALL Chromebooks ordered

FRESH AIR MTCE performed on all HVAC

Systems are Mechanically Ventilated (not OPEN)

System SURVEY not complete

TRANSPORTATION

Challenge is at WHITIN and UHS > MAX capacity = 25 students / bus

Question > CENTRALIZED bus stops VS House-to-House

SCHOOL COMMITTEE Questions:

1. 6' vs 3' spacing guidance
2. UPS claiming 6' spacing with NO mask is OK (need to verify)
3. WHITIN 100% capacity GR 4-7 not possible at 6' spacing
4. MASK USAGE must be universal
5. Environmental Concerns > AIRFLOW vs Classroom Temperature



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

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
