2020 EEO-5 data is due on July 27th; reporting is on track.

Dr. Dillon plans to present entry plan in approximately 30 days, after meeting with direct reports, School Committee members, etc. to determine common and individual priorities. He is attending Massachusetts Superintendents' Leadership Conference next week.

Wendy Phillips, former Director of Curriculum, will be retained on a per diem basis until August, to assist with creation of new math curriculum.
