2. New business

<p>A Public Body must post notice of the date, time and place of a meeting or hearing at least 48 hours in advance of said meeting or hearing, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays. The notice must include a list of topics the Chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting or hearing, specific enough so that the public can understand the agenda. Once posted, notice may be updated with additional topics, but only if re-posted 48 hours in advance of the meeting or hearing and in the same manner as set forth above. If a sudden, generally unexpected set of circumstances demands immediate action by a Public Body, an "emergency" meeting may be held, and notice shall be posted as soon as possible prior to said emergency meeting.</p>
