CONSERVATION PUBLIC HEARING/MEETING NOTICES

The Uxbridge Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, May 4th** at 6:30PM.

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Uxbridge Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. NOTICE OF INTENT filed by Allen Engineering and Associates on behalf of Steve Bevilacqua for work at 63 Linwood St, Map 12A Parcel 1233. The project is the construction of three new condominium units along with the existing dwelling unit, widening the driveway, and utility and stormwater improvements in the buffer zone of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland and Land Under Water. A portion of the site is in the Riverfront Area but there will be no new disturbance in that portion.

REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY filed by Shea Engineering & Surveying, Inc on behalf of Joseph and Bette Bartlett for work at 470 Hartford Ave. East, Map 7 Parcel 2355. The project will consist of excavating, filling, grading loaming and seeding to replace a failed septic system for a 4 bedroom, single family home. The work area is primarily within existing lawn area more than 50 ft from a bordering vegetated wetland.
