NOTICE OF INTENT filed by Tom Corbett ZP Battery Devco LLC for work at 186 Providence St Map 51 Parcel(s) 1939. The proposed project consists of the construction of a battery energy storage system (BESS). The proposed BESS includes five battery storage systems on concrete pads, transformers on concrete pads, underground electric connections, standpipes, a gravel driveway, fencing, stormwater features and appurtenances. Portions of the work is proposed within the 100' buffer zone, within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

NOTICE OF INTENT filed by Brandy Beaudette for work at 117 Carney Street (Map 24B Parcel 2923). The proposed project consists of the repair/replacement of an existing septic system. The proposed construction activities are within the 100' Buffer Zone of Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.
