CONSERVATION PUBLIC HEARING/MEETING NOTICES

The Uxbridge Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, August 3rd** at 6:30PM.

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Uxbridge Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation. No in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. REQUEST FOR AMENDED ORDER OF CONDITIONS filed by BSC Group on behalf of New England Power Company for work at Q143/R144 Transmission Line to amend Order of Conditions Special Condition #48(a) that "herbicides, pesticides, or chemical fertilizers shall not be used within wetland resource areas or 100-ft buffer zone of wetland resource areas" to conform with the Five-Year Vegetation Management Plan which includes herbicide application.

REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY filed by Capron Self Storage for work at 50 Depot St (Map 25 Parcel 1095). The work consists of clearing trees in the outer Riverfront Area, which is separated from the river by a road and stormwater basin.
