PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Uxbridge Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on **Monday, September 19, 2022 at 6:30PM** in **Lower Town Hall, Town Hall, 21 South Main Street, Uxbridge, MA**, to review the following applications under the MA Wetlands Protection Act (MGL Ch. 131, Sec. 40). Plans may be reviewed in the Conservation office during regular business hours.

NOTICE OF INTENT filed by TRC Companies, Inc. on behalf of Unilock for work located at 36 Commerce Drive. The proposed project includes modifications to an existing test well in order to provide process water to the facility. Work is proposed within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland and within Bordering Land Subject to Flooding.

REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY filed by Lisa Hilpl for work at 149 Old Millville Road, Uxbridge. The applicant proposes the removal of several trees that are dead and or dying on the bank of, and within the 200-foot Riverfront Area of, the Blackstone River.

REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY filed by SWCA Environmental Consultants on behalf of Eversource Energy for work in the roadway of Lackey Dam Road. The proposed project includes the construction of a new gas distribution pipeline within Lackey Dam Road. The proposed project will occur within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland.
