FY21-01: 502 and 486 Douglas Street, the applicant Uxbridge Gas and Market, LLC, is seeking a SPECIAL PERMIT, in accordance with the Uxbridge Zoning Bylaws Appendix B: Table of Uses, for a 5000 s.f. Filling Station/Convenience Store and drive through coffee shop with five (5) gasoline pump islands and two (2) high speed diesel pump islands. The applicant is also requesting a VARIANCE to the requirements of Zoning Section 400-10 D.3 that prohibit billboards which include any sign over forty (40) s.f. in area.
