Return Home Registry

• HOW IT WORKS

This Program will set up a database for the Uxbridge Police Department to utilize if a resident wanders off from their residence. First responders will try to reconnect residents with their families who experience a medical emergency or have wandered.

• WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Both young and older residents who have the tendency or possibility to wander are eligible to enroll. You can enroll by either registering on-line at <https://bit.ly/uxbridgereturn>, fill out the paper form, or call the senior center for assistance at 508-278-8622.

• EMERGENCY RESPONSE

In a wandering incident, the Uxbridge Police will be informed of the member's information to facilitate a fast, safe return to help families reunite. This program is free of charge.

Town of Uxbridge Return Home Registry Program

Loved ones with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, or other disabilities, are at great risk to wander from home.

In New England, weather conditions are hazardous much of the year. It is critical that public safety be in a position to respond quickly.

By registering, first responders have access to the patient's profile which contains medical conditions, allergies, medications taken, mobility issues, locations frequented, and other important information. Dispatch will relay this information to first responders to enable fast, accurate care.
