- 2. Abandoned plots/fall cleanup Fall cleanup was difficult this year because of rain. 5 barrels are still remaining. Several plots will be in need of work in the spring. Dave S. might plow plots in the spring and also fix roads.
- 3. Calendar for 2019 (including May meeting for all gardeners) Opening day April 20, 2019. End of season November 15. Applications available January 1, must be received by March 11. Evening in the gardens Aug 14 with rain date Aug 15.
- 4. Review of applications, policies, etc. for 2019 remind people no plastic decorations, etc. Will also add that statement to the FAQ. The ground rules will add "if fencing is not maintained it will be removed".
- 5. Security deposit/raise cost of garden plot? The cost of the garden will remain \$20/season for 2019. No security deposit at this time.
- 6. URI seed program to continue in 2019
- 7. Road closure? plan to stake all rows and use cable to block off all garden rows. A motion made and seconded to spend up to \$200 on material to block off roads.
